The 2012 Bela Voda Blanc offers plenty of Chardonnay character (despite only being 30% of the blend) with its apple blossom, spice, hints of toast and distinct minerality on both the nose and palate. Clean, medium-bodied, balanced and long, it's a superb white to enjoy over the coming couple of years. Coming from Macedonia and a project with Eric Solomon and Philippe Cambie, these efforts are full-throttle, decadently styled wines that remain beautifully drinkable and balanced.
