The 2013 Bela Voda Blanc, aged 7 months in 70% oak and 30% stainless steel, offers classy apple blossom, honey and mineral nuances to go with a medium-bodied, beautifully focused feel on the palate. It's outstanding and should drink nicely for 2-3 years, possibly longer. Coming from Macedonia and a project with Eric Solomon and Philippe Cambie, these efforts are full-throttle, decadently styled wines that remain beautifully drinkable and balanced.
